Redesignated: 601 Support Wing on 31 Mar 1992; 601 Air Base Wing on 1 Oct 1993. Inactivated on 31 Mar 1995. Redesignated 601 Air Expeditionary Wing, converted to provisional status, and assigned to USAFE to activate or deactivate at any time after 5 Feb 2001.

OPERATIONS. Working with United States Air Forces in Europe and other branches of the U.S. and Allied armed forces in Europe, planned, directed, manned, controlled, and provided logistical support for tactical air control functions required by HQ, Seventeenth Air Force. Operations included fixed and mobile radar air surveillance and control of the airspace primarily over West Germany. Owned air and ground forward air controller assets, 1972-1984. Following a major reorganization in Jun 1985, wing reduced to tactical control of aircraft, radar air surveillance, and helicopter operations. Turned over the last fixed radar site to the West German Air Force in Aug 1986. Provided air defense surveillance radar support to the government of Saudi Arabia, Oct 1980-.
